Tournament Conditions

- 1. The tournament shall be conducted within the laws of the game and the regulations adopted by Tennis NSW, except as altered by the conditions.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry into, or to combine or cancel events or transfer entries to different age group if considered insufficient entries have been received, or alter the program if deemed necessary.
- 3. This is a Tennis NSW and Tennis Seniors NSW sanctioned social round robin event. For insurance reasons, all players must be registered members of their State Tennis Association and be members of a State Tennis Seniors' Association. Failure to comply with this requirement may preclude you from competing in the Tournament. Membership with Tennis Seniors NSW is free for the first year, however players not wishing to join Tennis Seniors NSW must pay a fee of \$5.00 for the tournament.
- 4. All events will be round robin.
- 5. Winners will be decided on "Sets won", if tied, then "Games won", then "Games against" if still tied, then "Head-to-Head". Finally, if still tied, by the playing of an additional tie-breaker.
- 6. Minimum age requirement for Seniors' competition is 29 years. Senior players will be eligible to play their age group during the full year—i.e. a player who attains (say 30 years) on any date during, up to and including December 31st, will be eligible to play 30+ events for the full year.
- 7. Each competitor must submit a separate entry form, on or before the closing date, and only 1 event per time slot to be entered.
- 8. In entering the Tournament, a player automatically grants the right in perpetuity to make, use and show pictures of him/her, motion or still, taken during the competition without compensation.
- 9. Matches will commence at the time stipulated on the Entry Form. Play may continue under lights. Competitors must report to control at the venue 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.
- 10. Entries will close on 16 April 2021. Entries will ONLY be accepted ONCE PAYMENT has been received prior to tournament.
- 11. ETDTA Inc. and other clubs utilised for the event have Covid-19 Safety Plans in place. All participants are to follow the requirements of these plans.
